TXCHPI Policy Achievements

2008 - Obtained passage of legislation commissioning report on CHP's status and potential in Texas

2008 - Included CHP eligibility under statewide Energy Efficiency Incentive Program (EEIP)

2009 - Included energy security provisions in "Hurricane Ike" bills HB 1831 & HB 4409, requiring CHP feasibility studies in critical infrastructure (*More at www.txsecurepower.org*)

2010 - Implemented methodology in determining CHP incentive structure under EEIP

2011 - Passed HB 3268 creating a streamlined air permit for CHP systems
